Cycling in our City

Members of the public and members of the Chichester City Centre Neighbourhood Management Panel have raised concerns over the ongoing issue of people cycling on the pavements and within the precinct of the City Centre.

Due to this concern, local officers will be holding an Anti-Cycling Day this month. Officers will be stopping any person cycling in prohibited areas, educating them in regards to the City Centre cycling laws and issuing £30 fixed penalty notices when necessary.

Local officers regularly stop and confront cyclists cycling on the pavements or through the precinct and deal with them robustly. Over 20 stops have been made within the last month.

Our Neighbourhood Policing Team will be working with the local schools, College and University at the beginning of the new term in order to highlight the laws and potential dangers to all students and staff. Posters are also being distributed in our City to offer extra guidance and information to those who need it.
