Notification from Surrey Police

Please be aware that a female in Surrey reported a crime whereby she was a victim of a scam and is not being reimbursed.

The 22 year old victim received an e-mail from what she assumed was the HMRC. They stated she had a tax refund due, and needed her bank details to refund the money. She sent this and realised later that £1800 pounds had been illegally withdrawn. She phoned her bank and they closed the account access. She asked for a refund, but was told there would be none as she gave her details to a third party, and was therefore responsible. She is contacting her insurance to see if this covers her loss.

For your information NEVER give your personal details such as PINs Bank details etc, to anyone, no one requires them.
