Property Marking

Chichester

Chichester: Oving Road

Burglary: Between 2030hrs and 2100hrs 12/2 entry has been gained to a property and an Xbox games console has been stolen.

Burglary: Police are appealing for information following a burglary at a jewellers in Chichester. Officers attended Ernest Jones in East Street, Chichester, shortly after 2.15am 15/2 following a report that the shop had been broken into.

It is believed that three men smashed the window of the shop, stole jewellery and then ran from the scene in an easterly direction along East Street before heading north into St Martins.

Detective Inspector Jim McKnight of West Sussex CID said: "We would like to hear from anyone who was in the area around the time of the incident and saw three men actiing suspiciously near to Ernest Jones or three men leaving the area carrying a holdall.

"We would also like to hear from anyone who is offered jewellery for sale."

Fishbourne: Salthill Road
