Community Resolution

This is an alternative way of dealing with less serious offences and allows officers to use their professional judgement when dealing with offenders. It can be applied to offences such as low level public order, criminal damage, theft, and minor assaults.

When used in appropriate circumstances, Community Resolution will enable victims to reach effective resolution and closure to the crime which affected them. Offenders will receive speedy justice and there will be reduced bureaucracy for police officers.

Chichester

Chichester: Avenue De Chartres

Anti Social Behaviour: At approximately 3.45pm 2/3 a group of youths were seen throwing stones at moving traffic from the top of the multi story car park. Police attended and details gained from the youths. They will be dealt with by means of a Community Resolution.

Break to Shed: Over the period of week, access was gained to three insecure sheds at the location. A quantity of bathroom fittings were stolen.

Chichester: East Street

Police have made arrests following burglaries at two Chichester jewellers in East Street at around 2am today (Wednesday 7 March).

Police were alerted to a break-in at Gold Arts, after a member of the public reported seeing men hammering at the window with sledgehammers. Shortly after the alarm at Ernest Jones was activated.

PC Ali Hutchings said: "Police arrived on the scene within a minute of the report and an immediate search was launched. A car was seen to make off down Marsh Lane towards the A259, which stopped at Drayton. One man stayed in the car and was arrested and a second man was tracked through the field by a dog unit before being arrested in the grounds of White Whyke House.

"This is an ongoing investigation and officers are continuing to gather evidence. I would like to thank the quick thinking members of the public who called police immediately on seeing the break-in. Anyone with information who has yet to make contact is asked to call us or Crimestoppers as soon as possible."

A 31-year-old man from Havant, Hampshire, and a 25-year-old man from Chichester have been arrested on suspicion of burglary and are currently in custody awaiting interview.
