Chichester

Pound Farm Road:

Damage to Vehicle: Overnight 19/4 to 20/4 a vehicle parked at the location was damaged, receiving scratches to the side panels.

Did you see or hear anything?

Sussex Police STORM: 827 20/04/12 refers.

Appledram Lane North:

Damage to Vehicle: Overnight 20/4 to 21/4 it is believed that damage was caused to a vehicle parked at the location and the tyres were damaged.

Do you know anything about this?

Newlands Lane:

Nuisance Behaviour: At approximately 12.15pm 22/4 we received reports of off road bikes causing a disturbance to local residents at the location. Officers attended, gave the riders words of advice about their behaviour and moved them on.

Baxendale Road:

Break to Shed: Between 14/4 and 20/4 access was gained to a bike shed and a white "Caera Fury" mountain bike was stolen.

Have you seen this bike?

Worcester Road:

Damage to Vehicle: Between 20/4 and 22/4 damage was caused to a vehicle parked at the location, receiving scratch marks along the panels.

Did you see or hear anything?

Sussex Police STORM: 0020 23/04/12 refers.

Broyle Road:

Nuisance Behaviour: On 23/4 we received a report of an ongoing issue whereby cyclists are cycling on the pavements causing a danger to pedestrians. Local officers are aware of the issues which are spread across the District and will deal robustly with any person caught.

Kingsham Road:

Criminal Damage: Between 8pm and 11pm 13/4 damage was caused to a window at the location, believed to have been damaged by local youths playing football in the area.

Answoth Close:

Theft of Bike: Between 4pm 24/4 and 9pm 25/4 a blue "Specialized Hard Rock Sport 2007" bike was stolen from a bike shed at the location.

Bognor Road:

Theft of Bike: At approximately 2.30pm 24/4 an insecure ladies bike with a basket on the front was stolen from a rear garden at the location.

Sherborne Road:

Egged House: Just past midnight on 27/4 eggs were thrown at a house at the location.

East Street: Gold Arts

Break to Premises: Overnight 26/4 to 27/4 a window of the premises was broken. It is unknown at this stage if any items were stolen.

Chichester Rural West

Chidham: Chidham Lane

Drugs: During a routine patrol in the area on 20/4, officers stopped four males. Drugs were found on all four males and they were issued with a Cannabis Street Warning.

Bosham: Bosham Lane

Damage to Door: Between 20/4 and 22/4 damage was caused to a glass pane of a door at the location.

Nuisance Behaviour: At approximately 5.45pm 22/4 we received reports of off road bikes causing a disturbance in the area. Police attended but could not locate the riders.

West Stoke: Kingley Vale National Nature Reserve

Damage to Gate: Between 21/4 and 23/4 damage was caused to the gates at the location and access gained to the reserve. It is suspected that poachers were responsible although there is currently no evidence to support this.

East Ashling:

Break to Barn: At approximately 3.45am 26/4 an alarm was activated and a person seen running away from a barn at the location. Access was gained to the barn but no items were reported stolen. Did you see or hear anything?

Break to Store: Between 24/4 and 26/4 access was gained to a chemical store at the location. No items were reported stolen.
