Chichester

Chichester: North Street

Theft of Lead: Between 1800hrs 4/1 and 1000hrs 5/1 an amount of lead sheeting has been stolen from the roof of a building.

Did you see anything suspicious?

Chichester: Orchard Street

Theft of Lead: Between 1130hrs and 1330hrs 6/1 a large amount of lead building materials have been stolen from a building site whilst left unattended.

Chichester: Kingsham Avenue

Theft of paving: Between 21/12 and 25/12 ten paving slabs have been stolen from an insecure allotment.

Chichester: Spitalfield Lane

Theft of bike: Between 1200hrs and 2000hrs 7/1 a black 'GT Palomar' road bike has been stolen whilst left insecure and unattended.

Have you seen this bike?

Chichester: Osborne Crescent

Kidnapping: Police are still trying to trace a suspect after a man was kidnapped in Chichester in the early hours of Sunday 8 January.

The 27-year-old victim was assaulted and taken from outside a property in Osborne Crescent at about 3am. He was later found in Chichester at about 2pm and taken to hospital having suffered cracked ribs and bruising. His injuries are not life threatening. Firearms officers were deployed to the scene as a precaution because of the type of incident.

Police want to stress that group of people involved are all known to each other and there is no danger to the public.

They want to speak to a 24-year-old local man about the incident. Anyone with information or may have witnessed what happened is asked to come forward and contact Sussex Police on 101 quoting Operation Cyclone or alternatively contact the independent charity Crimestoppers anonymously on 0800 555111.

Chichester: College Lane

Criminal Damage: Between 1730hrs 12/1 and 0910hrs 13/1 two bricks have been thrown through the window of an office. No entry has been gained and nothing has been stolen.

Bosham: The Drive
