Chichester

Chichester:

Sussex Police have received two reports of dogs being poisoned in the Chichester area over the last two months, but have stressed that there are no confirmed reports of incidents on local beaches.

The first was a report of rat poison placed in bread in an alleyway in The Holdens, Bosham, on February 20, but there is no evidence to suggest that this was maliciously placed. Local advice was given through community messaging and Neighbourhood Watch.

Another report was received on Thursday (March 29) of an English Bull Terrier that died after suspected poisoning. The owner believes that the dog may have eaten something while out walking at Sidlesham on Sunday, March 25, but there is no clear confirmation of this.

Sergeant Alan Fenn from Chichester's Manhood neighbourhood policing team said: "We are liaising with Chichester District Council dog wardens, local land owners and dog walkers, but at this time there appears to be just these two confirmed incidents and no obvious links between them. There have been a number of rumours circulating about 'poison sandwich' incidents on the beaches of East and West Witterings, but these have not been confirmed.

"I would appeal to any person who suspects their dog has been deliberately targeted or poisoned to report this to police or dog wardens immediately, and ask dog walkers to be vigilant and report any suspicious activity or objects they find. Any reports received will be investigated thoroughly."

Chichester: Broyle Road

Nuisance Behaviour: At approximately 4pm 01/4 we received reports of a group of youths causing a disturbance in the local area. Police attended the area but could not locate the youths.

Break to Shed: Between 2/4 and 4/4 access was gained to a secured area and garden equipment was stolen from the communal sheds.

Theft of Bike: Between 5.30pm 2/4 and 10am 3/4 an insecure blue "Apollo" mountain bike was stolen from a bike rack at the location.

Overnight 4/4 and 5/4 damage was caused to a vehicle parked at the location. A wing mirror was broken off and panels of the vehicle damaged and dented.

Theft of Bike: Between 9pm 4/4 and 8.30am 5/4 an insecure "Raleigh" black and grey mountain bike was stolen from the location.

Chichester: Pound Farm Road

Damage to Vehicle: Between 4/4 and 5/4 damage was caused to two vehicles parked at the location. Both vehicles had scratch marks along the panels.

Theft of Bike: At approximately 5pm 6/4 an insecure blue "Carrera" mountain bike was stolen when left unattended for a few moments.

Did you see anyone take this bike?

Damage to Vehicle: Between 7.30pm and 9pm 6/4 a vehicle parked at the location was damaged and a wing mirror pulled off.

Damage to Vehicles: Overnight 6/4 and 7/4 two vehicles parked at the location were damaged and access gained. The ignition barrels were tampered with but attempts to steal the vehicle were unsuccessful.

Attempt Break: At approximately 5.30am 07/4 an attempt was made to gain access to a garage in the area. Police attended promptly but could not locate the males. Bolt croppers were recovered for the location and investigations are ongoing.

Prinsted: Prinsted Lane

Theft of Dinghy: Over a period of a month a blue dinghy named "Seagulls" was stolen from the location.

Burglary: Overnight 2/4 and 3/4 access was gained to a number of properties within the local area. Numerous items were stolen including iPads, laptops and mobile phones. Investigations into these burglaries are still continuing and one male was arrested for handling stolen goods.

Flytipping: Reports of ongoing problems with quantities of manure and other unwanted items being dumped at the location.
