Across the district there is an increase in breaks to outbuildings, sheds and garages. Please ensure these are as secure as possible. Even if you don't believe you have anything valuable in them. Please ensure any connecting doors between garages and houses are firmly secure and locked.

**Chichester: Portfield Quarry**

**Burglary:** Break to premise around 1am on 11/01. Entry was gained via cutting the surrounding fence. Tools from a warehouse were stolen.
