Community Resolution

This is an alternative way of dealing with less serious offences and allows officers to use their professional judgement when dealing with offenders. It can be applied to offences such as low level public order, criminal damage, theft, and minor assaults.

When used in appropriate circumstances, Community Resolution will enable victims to reach effective resolution and closure to the crime which affected them. Offenders will receive speedy justice and there will be reduced bureaucracy for police officers.

Chichester

Franklin Place:

Damage to Vehicle: Overnight 21/6 to 22/6 a vehicle parked at the location was damaged and the length of the vehicle was keyed.

Did you see or hear anything?

Market Avenue:

Anti Social Behaviour: At approximately 11.30pm 22/6 we received a report of a group of youths in a car park at the location causing playing football, being rowdy and causing a disturbance to local residents.

Criminal Damage: At approximately 2.45pm 23/6 the window of the pub was smashed by a male. Police attended and arrested the male for criminal damage.

West Street:

Bike Theft: Between 9am and 1pm 22/6 a blue mountain bike, secured to a bike rack at the location was stolen.

Have you seen this bike?

Juxon Close:

Burglary: Between 20/6 and 24/6 access was gained to a property in the area. An untidy search was made and items stolen.

Church Road:

Break to Garage: Between 15/6 and 16/6 access was gained to a garage at the location and two bikes were stolen.

Sussex Police STORM: 951 24/06/12 refers.

Kingsham Road:

Police arrested a man after a 16-year old girl reported being raped in a grassed area beside Kingsham Road, Chichester, near Chichester High School of Boys, shortly before midnight on Sunday 24 June. Police swiftly

searched the area and went to an address in the same road just after midnight, where they arrested a 28-year old man on suspicion of rape. The enquiry is still at an early stage and the full circumstances have not yet been established. The girl did not receive any physical injury and has been interviewed by specially trained detectives. The male has been released on bail until 8 August while inquiries continue.

Seddon Close:

Theft: At approximately 1.45am 26/6 two males were seen stealing a blue Peugeot Motorcycle from the area. Police attended but could not locate the vehicle the bike had been loaded onto and enquiries are ongoing.

Whyke Road:

Damage to Vehicle: Between 19/6 and 23/6 a vehicle parked at the location had the side panels keved.

Break to Garage: Over a 7 week period access was gained to a garage at the end of a property

and tools were stolen from within.
