Community Resolution

This is an alternative way of dealing with less serious offences and allows officers to use their professional judgement when dealing with offenders. It can be applied to offences such as low level public order, criminal damage, theft, and minor assaults.

When used in appropriate circumstances, Community Resolution will enable victims to reach effective resolution and closure to the crime which affected them. Offenders will receive speedy justice and there will be reduced bureaucracy for police officers.

Chichester

Florence Road:

Anti Social Behaviour: Ongoing concerns regarding travellers in the area riding quad bikes on the grass area. Travellers have since moved from the location.

Whyke Road:

Bike Theft: Overnight 28/6 and 29/6 access was gained to a rear garden and two bikes were stolen. A black bike with a wicker basket and a silver BMX were stolen.

Criminal Damage: At approximately 3am 30/6 we received reports of a door being smashed at the station. Police attended and arrested a male.

Criminal Damage: Overnight 30/6 to 1/7 a garden gate of a property was damaged at the location.

Break to Phone Box: At approximately 9pm 3/7 a phone box at the location was broken into and a quantity of cash stolen.

Criminal Damage: Overnight 2/7 to 3/7 a vehicle parked at the location had all four tyres slashed. Did you see or hear anything?

Burglary: Overnight 4/7 to 5/7 access was gained to the premises and petty cash stolen from within.

Bosham: Williams Road

Damage to Vehicle: Overnight 29/6 to 30/6 damage was caused to a vehicle parked at the location. The wing mirror was broken and a side panel dented and scratched.

Shed Break: Over a week period an insecure shed at the location was entered and garden equipment was stolen from within.

Burglary: At approximately 11am 4/7 a male cold calling in the area attended an address offering to buy jewellery. The male entered the property and was shown jewellery by the home owner. The male then left claiming to review prices and it is believed that a watch was stolen as he exited. Police attended and located the male. He was arrested and the investigation is continuing.
