Manhood East

Selsey: High Street

Theft: Between 3pm and 6.30pm 13/4 a wheelchair was stolen from the location. Three youths were stopped with a wheelchair within this time frame in the local area. The local officer is making enquiries to establish the full facts of how the youths came across the wheelchair.

Jury Lane: ACM Aquatic Service

Break to Business: Between 11/4 and 13/4 access was gained to the premises. A quantity of stock and computer equipment was stolen from within.

Did you see or hear anything?

Selsey: West Street

Suspicious Vehicle: At approximately 10.50am 16/4 a female was approached by a male in a black car in the area. The male requested she get in his car. The female carried on and went to a nearby family member.

Anti Social Behaviour: At approximately 7pm 16/4 we received a report of youths climbing on the roof of a store at the location. Police attended and moved the youths on, advising them of the dangers. Local officers are making enquiries with the store to improve security.

Criminal Damage: Between 15/4 and 16/4 a bus shelter at the location was damaged and one pane of glass was smashed.
