Property Marking

Manhood East

Selsey: Spinney Close

Attempt Burglary: Between 12/2 and 19/2 an attempt has been made to gain entry to a secure property. The attempt failed and no entry was gained and nothing was stolen.

Did you see or hear anything suspicious?

Selsey: High Street

Bike Theft: At approximately 1900hrs 19/2 an insecure silver 'Specialised Hard Rock' mountain bike has been stolen whilst left unattended outside a shop.

Selsey: Greenlawns Caravan Park
