Property Marking

Selsey: High Street

Burglary: Between 1830hrs 28/1 and 0705hrs 29/1 a premises has been broken in to and a large amount of cigarettes and tobacco were stolen from within. As a direct result of information received from members of the public 4 local boys were arrested.
