Manhood East

Selsey: St Peters Crescent

Bike Theft: Between 4am and 6.30am 13/7 two pints of milk and a carton of orange juice were stolen from a doorstep at the location.

Selsey: Glen Crescent

Bike Theft: Between 8.30am and 3.20pm two children's bikes were stolen when left insecure on a driveway.
