There have been several reports across the district of a cold caller offering sharpening services for a cheap price. When returning the items after sharpening they are charging an excessive amount of money. Do not use services such as this and report to Police and Trading Standards.

Manhood East

Selsey: Robinson Close

Break: Garage break between 01/08 and 18/11. No signs of a break to the doors. Pressure washer and bottles of champagne were stolen from the garage.

Selsey: Croft Road

Anti-social behaviour: Youths banging on windows of properties. Police attended location to search for youths.

Cold callers: Reports of loft insulation company door knocking. Police attended and confirmed the company had sales representatives in the area.

Birdham: Crooked Lane

Burglary: Front door of property forced, entry gained. Nothing was stolen from within the premise. It occurred before 2:30pm on 16/11.

Itchenor: Shipton Green

Cold Caller: Male offering sharpening services, when returning items he was charging a large amount of money. He has been spoken to by officers and the relevant details passed to trading standards.

Bracklesham Bay: Beech Avenue

Nuisance youths: Youths seen pulling at fencing at the location and shouting and swearing. Police attended and youths spoken to. No damage was caused.

Please report all antisocial behaviour on 101.
