Manhood

21st September 2012 - 28th September 2012

Lead theft is an ongoing problem across the district. Try to prevent yourself from becoming a victim of crime by ensuring there is no easy access to your roof such as insecure ladders, water butts or waste bins making it easier to climb. Consider covering the lead with tar to make removal difficult. Consider installing security lighting. If you discover your roof has been damaged from lead theft then call us on the non emergency number 101.

Manhood East

Sesley: East Beach Road

Theft: Between 4:30pm 21/9 and 7pm 21/9 a black bag containing diving equipment was stolen from the beach at the location.
