Manhood East

Sidlesham Common: Chichester Road

Theft: Overnight 8/7 and 9/7 access was gained to a business compound at the location and a number of tyres were stolen from within.

Did you see anyone in the area acting suspiciously?

Runcton: Vinnetrow Road

Break to Business: Overnight 9/7 and 10/7 access was gained to a building and the tills and gaming machines were broken into. Extensive damage was caused and a quantity of cash stolen from within.

Selsey: Chichester Road

Theft: Overnight 9/7 and 10/7 a garden aluminium chair was stolen.

Burglary: Between 3/7 and 12/7 access was gained to a property and a safe and a nail gun were stolen from within.

Selsey: St Peters Cresent

Bike Theft: Overnight 12/7 and 13/7 an orange BMX, left insecure at the location was stolen.

West Wittering: Roman Landing

Damage: Overnight 4/7 and 5/7 an oak public footpath sign was snapped off and thrown in a nearby hedge.

Birdham: Main Road

Attempt Theft: Overnight 6/7 and 7/7 an attempt was made to remove a secure boat from the location. No theft occurred as it appears the offenders were potentially disturbed.

Bracklesham Bay: East Bracklesham Drive

Nuisance Behaviour: During the early hours of 10/7 we received reports of a group of youths outside the location causing a nuisance and being rowdy. Police attended and spoke with the males, giving them suitable words or advice and moving them on from the location.
