Vehicle Breaks

Over the weekend period a number of vehicles in the Chichester area were damaged and gained entry to.

A vehicle in Gordon Road, Southbourne had the lock drilled and items stolen from the boot. A van parked in the area of Albert Road, Chichester had the lock cut from the side door and access was gained. Two chainsaws and a strimmer were stolen. A second van was tampered with and the door forced to gain entry in the area of Frederick Road and a vehicle in Woodlands Lane had the window smashed and a squash racket was stolen from within.

Burglary Dwelling and Burglary OTD (other than dwelling)

Again, over the weekend periods a number of locations were targeted by thieves in the area. In the area of Station Road, Bosham a property was entered and items of jewellery and a carriage clock were stolen.

In the location of Main Road, Fishbourne a storage container was broken into and two chainsaws were stolen and in the area of Garland Square, Tangmere a garage was forced open but no items reported stolen.

Please ensure that you take extra care with your belongings. Remove all valuables from vehicles and ensure that garages, sheds and homes are as secure as they can be.
