

North Mundham Neighbourhood Plan May 2019 Newsletter

Plans are now taking shape for the development of a Neighbourhood Plan for the Parish of North Mundham.

A Neighbourhood Plan is a way for local communities to shape and decide the future of their areas. Once formally adopted a Neighbourhood Plan will form part of the development plan used by Chichester District Council in determining planning applications.

The plan, compiled by residents of the Parish, will form a guide to the local authority and developers on how the community wishes to manage and control future development in the Plan Area over the next 15 years. This will include community facilities, services and the natural environment.

A lot of work will need to be done over the next 12 to 15 months to deliver a successful plan and this will require help and input from the community. Volunteers are needed to help in the various working groups. Over the coming months the Neighbourhood Plan group will be holding public events and conducting surveys so that everyone can play their part in creating the final plan.

On **Saturday 8th June** there will be an open day and exhibition at the North Mundham Village Hall, where residents can drop in and talk to the team, ask questions and record their views and opinions on what should be included in the plan.

It's vital that we capture all of the community issues and objectives for the whole Parish so we can create the policies and action plan to meet the resident's vision for sustainable growth.
