The Parish Council is the first tier of local government and can play a vital part in representing the interests of the community.

The Parish Council is non-political and runs completely independently from the District and County Council.

YOUR COUNCILLORS

The civil parish consists of the villages of North Mundham, South Mundham, Runcton and the hamlets of Bowley and Fisher. With a total of nine councillors we attempt to have representatives for each different area. Contact details are always available via our website, as well as on the noticeboards in various locations throughout the parish. Contact the Council Office if you need details.

YOUR MEETINGS

The Parish Council meets on the first Tuesday of alternate months, at 7.15pm. The Parish Council Planning Committee meets on the first Tuesday of every month commencing at 6.45pm

Members of the public are welcome to attend and to ask questions during a specific time set aside for them. The public are also most welcome to attend these committees:

All meetings take place in the small hall at North Mundham Village Hall, School Lane, North Mundham.
